

RECOMMENDATIONS--

OVERALL: TREAT WILDLIFE TRADE AS PUBLIC HEALTH AND NATIONAL SECURITY ISSUE

- 1. BAN COMMERCIAL TRADE IN WILD ANIMALS (Let them stay in their natural “homes”)**
- 2. COMPENSATE/TRANSITION LEGAL ANIMAL DEALERS TO OTHER VOCATIONS**
- 3. SEIZE ASSETS FROM ILLEGAL DEALERS → WILDLIFE RECOVERY FUND**
