After a night of direct travel from the U.S., you will land at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) in Nairobi. You will be met by a representative from the Kenya Tourism Board (KTB) and have a brief meeting with the KTB staff before you are transferred to Wilson Airport for a flight to Lewa Downs.

Location: Maasai Mara

Direct Air Transfer: from Lewa Downs

Overview: May 2006 was a landmark date for conservation in the Maasai Mara with the formation of Olare Orok Conservancy bordering the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. This was the date when a deal was brokered with the 277 Maasai landowners that has since become the template for the Mara community wildlife conservancies and a blueprint for the sustainability of the greater Maasai Mara ecosystem. The Conservancy later expanded to also encompass Motorogi lands, thereby becoming **OLARE MOTOROGI CONSERVANCY**.

The visit to the northern border of the reserve grants a guest plenty of wildlife because it is less frequented by visitors, owing to the exclusivity of the conservancy. Take your safari in the summer and you will experience the Great Wildebeest Migration! It is rated as one of the world's most spectacular natural events - every year over a million **wildebeest**, zebra and antelope **migrate** clockwise around the Serengeti-Masai Mara ecosystem, taking in two different countries and making time for birthing, courting and mating on the way.

Day 5 In Country:

LAMU

Location: Lamu Island

Transfers: Guests will transfer from Maasai Mara to Lamu via Nairobi by air to arrive in Lamu at approximately 1545hrs

Overview: Lamu Old Town is the oldest and best-preserved Swahili settlement in East Africa, retaining its traditional functions. Built in coral stone and mangrove timber, the town is characterized by the simplicity of structural forms enriched by such features as inner courtyards, verandas, and elaborately carved wooden doors. Lamu has hosted major Muslim religious festivals since the 19th century, and has become a significant centre for the study of Islamic and Swahili cultures.



The town is characterized by narrow streets and magnificent stone buildings with impressive curved doors, influenced by the unique fusion of Swahili, Arabic, Persian, Indian and European building styles. The buildings on the seafront with their arcades and open verandas provide a unified visual impression of the town when approaching it from the sea. The vernacular buildings are internally decorated with painted ceilings, large niches (madaka), small niches (zidaka), and pieces of Chinese porcelain. The buildings are well preserved and carry a long history that represents the development of Swahili building technology, based on coral, lime and mangrove poles. Activities our guests may experience in Lamu include:

- Culture of the local people
- Swahili cuisine/seafood
- Sunset Dhow sailing
- Luxury accommodation
- Donkey back riding
- Heena painting
- Turtle hatching (depending on the hatching season)

Day 6 In Country:

LAMU

Overview: Continuation of the activities listed above due to late arrival into Lamu the previous day.

- Guests will wake up to the sounds of oceans waves and a cool breeze from the Indian Ocean.
- Guests will enjoy a Swahili breakfast overlooking the Indian Ocean.

**Day 7 In Country:****LAMU/NAIROBI****Transfer from Lamu directly to Nairobi by air with a late evening arrival**

Overview: The name "Nairobi" comes from the Maasai phrase Enkare Nairobi, which translates to "cool water". The phrase is also the Maasai name of the Nairobi river, which in turn lent its name to the city. However, it is popularly known as the Green City in the Sun, and is surrounded by several expanding villa suburbs.

You will be picked up and transferred to Carnivore for dinner with KTB and later transfer to JKIA for departure to the U.S.
